



STUDENT PERSONAL DEVICE ARRANGEMENT

Due to the ongoing learning from home arrangements in place, Tullimbar Public School gives families the option to permit their child to bring their own laptop, iPad or tablet to school to engage in online learning. While our school does have technology available to students, it is insufficient for our current needs.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITY

- Parents must complete the online form
 - Giving details of the device (brand, type, serial number)
 - Current condition
 - Permission for the child to bring the device to school
- Ensure that the child can transport the device safely to and from school, e.g., in a protective bag or case, labelled with the child's name
- Ensure that the device and all accessories are clearly labelled with the child's name
- Ensure that there is no inappropriate content on the device (photos, music, videos, applications)
- Agree that any damage/loss sustained is not the responsibility of the school

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY

- Students must agree to use the device for educational purposes only
- Take responsibility and care of the device and accessories both at school and in transit
- Ensure that the device is fully charged before school and, where possible bring a charger for use during the day
- Not allow or share your device and accessories with any other student.

TEACHER RESPONSIBILITY

- Provide reasonable supervision of the use of devices
- Use the device to enhance educational engagement
- Provide a safe storage area in the classroom for break times and when the device is not in use
- Not allow another student to use one student's device or accessories
